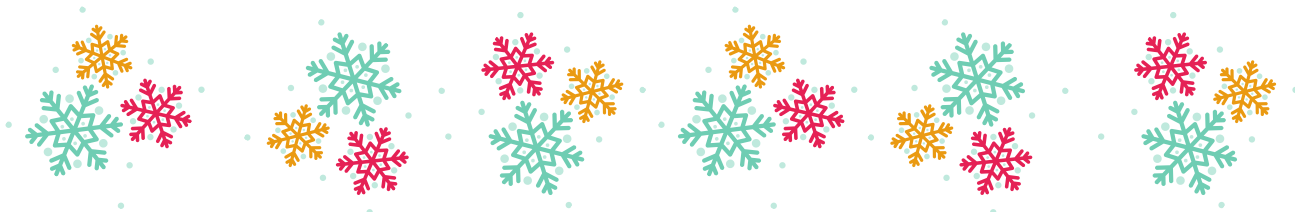
Long Winter's Nap
